**Compost Bins:** All food waste, Chinet plates, napkins and compostable cups and utensils. (Most of the waste from our food-related events!)

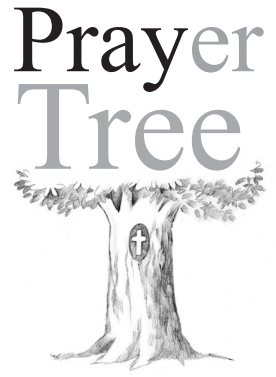
**Recycling:** Plastic cups (that aren't labeled compostable), plastic bottles, cans, clean paper, etc.
