## A Note from Fr. Chris



Dear Friends,

August 6th and 9th this past week mark the 79th year since Hiroshima and Nagasaki were devastated by atomic bombs. Hundreds of thousands of people lost their lives, their homes and land; lost family and loved ones. Thousands bore the scars, physical and emotional, for decades after.

Wars among and against people have destroyed the peace and promise of a good and prosperous life for generations and generations. Violence continues to be a plague wherever we turn.

Bullets are flying here in our own neighborhood. To date, King County reports 20 deaths due to firearms since the start of the year. 73 people were wounded by bullets in the same period and 407 shot were fired. Just days ago 4 people were wounded by gunfire in Capitol Hill.

Pope Francis gives us valuable reminders of our own personal responsibility towards a world of peace. He wrote: "To be true followers of Jesus today includes embracing his teaching about nonviolence." "An ethics of fraternity and peaceful coexistence between individuals and among peoples cannot be based on the logic of fear, violence and closed mindedness, but on responsibility, respect and sincere dialogue."

Many of us love and pray the 'Prayer of St. Francis' which begins with the words: "Lord, make me an instrument of your peace." This is a worthy and much needed petition we can all pray. We wish to bring peace to others and we wish for peace within our own hearts.

Yes, let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me.
