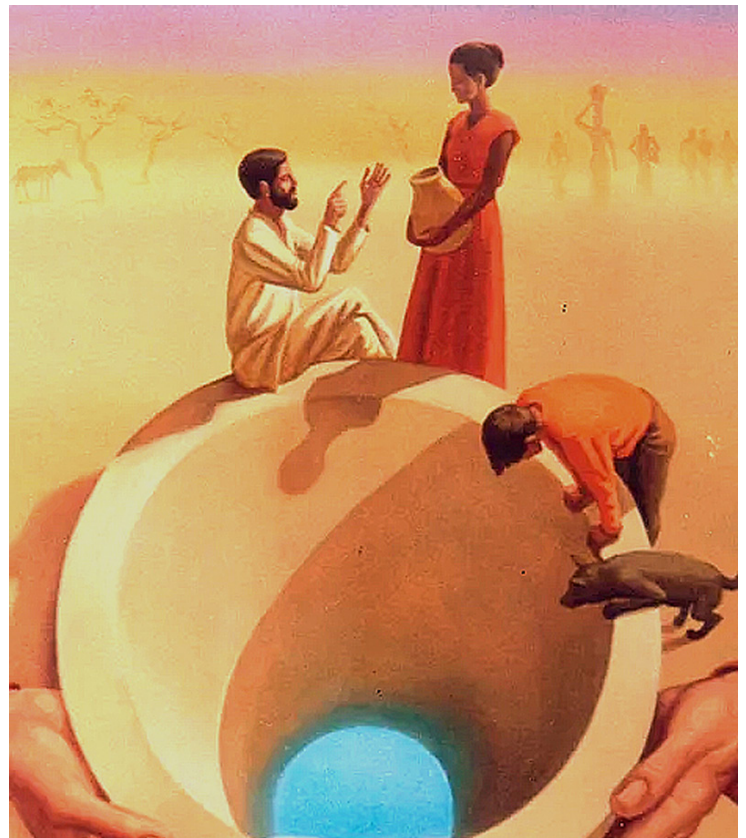

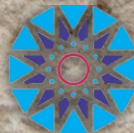

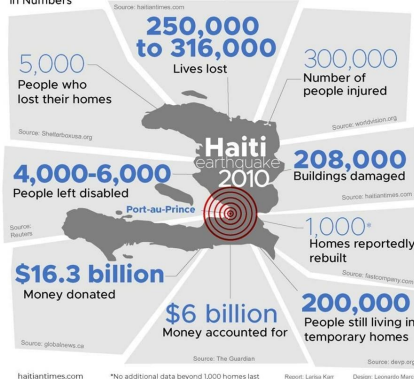

Just Haiti works with communities of coffee growers in Haiti to enable them to build a sustainable future through sales of their produce.
