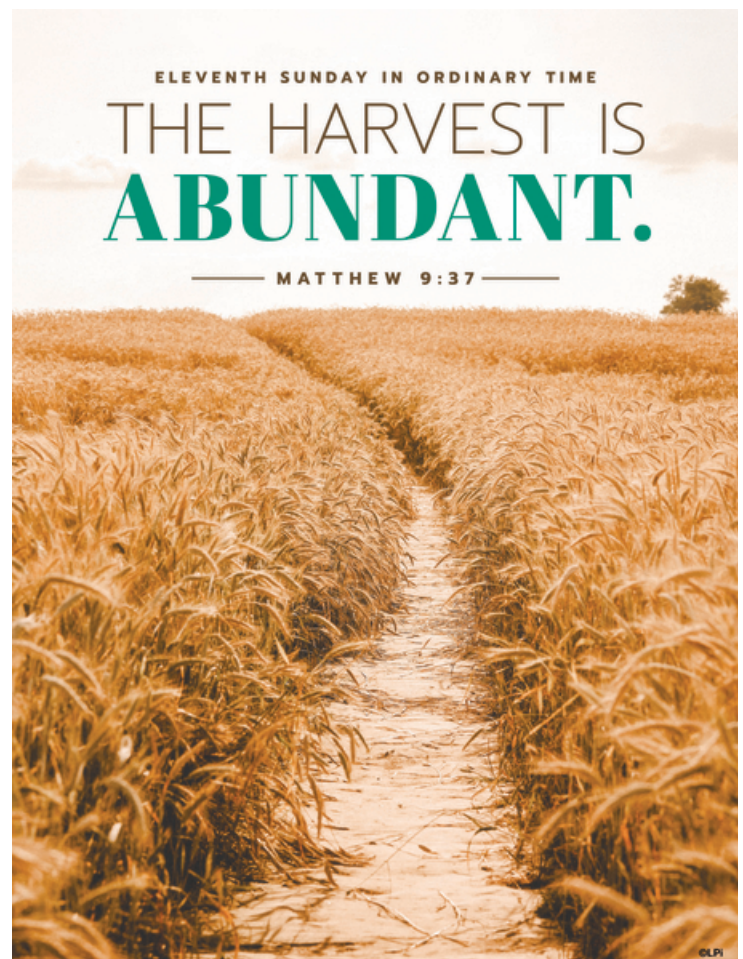

Parish Advocates

A Quiet Ministry That Can Heal

Each year, the Annual Catholic Appeal invites us to look beyond our own parish walls and see the quiet, courageous work happening across our Archdiocese. One ministry, supported by the ACA, that we want to lift up today is the work of our Parish Annulment Advocates—a ministry most parishioners never see, but one that can bring profound healing to those carrying the weight of a broken marriage.

Below are notes from one of our Parish Advocates, Peggy O'Brien-Murphy.

The annulment process can feel overwhelming. It asks people to revisit painful memories, to sort through years of confusion, and to trust a Church process they may not fully understand. Petitioners often describe it as a maze, full of forms, questions, and emotions they weren't expecting. And yet, there are times that with the help of trained advocates, internal changes can happen. A corner can be turned. Trust can grow. Understanding can deepen. Healing can take root.

Parish Advocates walk with people at one of the most vulnerable moments of their lives. They help them navigate a process the Church has refined over centuries—gathering documents, preparing testimony, and ensuring that every person is treated with dignity and compassion. They help clarify what an annulment truly is: **not a Catholic divorce**, but a declaration that something essential was missing at the time vows were exchanged. Advocates can help dispel fears and clarify misunderstandings. For example, receiving an annulment does not render children illegitimate.

This ministry exists because of the Annual Catholic Appeal. Your gift forms advocates, trains tribunal staff, and supports the pastoral care that allows people to move forward with peace, clarity, and renewed hope.

Today, I ask you to join me in supporting this work. Your generosity helps our Church accompany those who are hurting, confused, or searching for healing. It helps us be a Church that listens, guides, and restores.

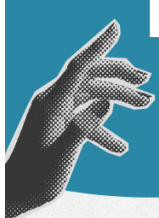

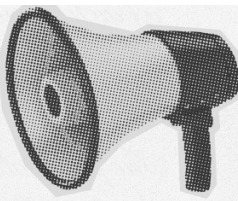

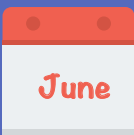
